CIVIC CENTER TO GET MAJOR UPDATES

Big improvements are on the way to one of our community's most popular gathering spots! The Humble City Council has approved two renovation projects to keep the Civic Center in great shape for years to come. The arena roof will be replaced in the coming months, with work expected to wrap up by January. The project comes in under the amount the city originally set aside in this year's budget — always good news! In addition, the Civic Center's chiller system will be rebuilt to improve efficiency and reliability. All events will continue as planned. These updates are part of the city's ongoing commitment to maintaining safe, comfortable, and welcoming spaces for residents and visitors alike.

NEW MEMORIAL AT SHALOM BARUCH



A new permanent memorial has been unveiled at the Shalom Baruch Jewish Cemetery in Humble. The installation, the first of its kind in North America, features a 12-foot monument inspired by the Star of David and a smaller sculpture

created from recovered shrapnel. The dedication ceremony, held on October 29, brought together community members, civic leaders, and faith representatives, offering a moment of shared reflection. The memorial serves as a space for remembrance, honoring those affected by recent global events while



emphasizing unity and resilience. It also highlights the ongoing commitment of the local Jewish community to preserving memory and fostering understanding. Visitors are welcome during the cemetery's regular hours to view the site and pay their respects.
