

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The City of Humble is requesting bids for the **Surface Water Line Extension to Well 9 Project**. This project involves the installation of approximately 3,000 LF of 16" diameter water line to connect the 16" water line from Well No. 6 to the ground storage tank at Well No. 9 and includes installation of a 12" Disinfection booster station at the Well No. 9 site as well as all labor, equipment, materials, and incidentals required to complete the project.

Sealed bids, in duplicate, addressed to the Finance Director, City of Humble, 114 West Higgins, Humble, Texas, 77338 shall be labeled "Sealed Bid Number 2026-03 DO NOT OPEN" to be received no later than 2:00 PM, local time, on Tuesday, April 7, 2026. Bids received after that time will not be accepted. Bids will be opened publicly and read aloud at that time in the City Council Chambers.

A virtual Pre-Bid conference will be held at 2:00 PM, local time, Tuesday, March 31, 2026, via Microsoft Teams. Attendance at the Pre-Bid conference is not mandatory.

It is the sole responsibility of the bidder to insure that his bid is actually in the City of Humble Finance Director's office prior to the expiration of the time and date above first written.

Bid security in the amount of five (5) percent of the greatest amount bid must accompany each bid in accordance with the General Instructions to Bidders. Bids will be required to be submitted under a condition of irrevocability for a period of ninety (90) days after bid opening.

It shall be each bidder's sole responsibility to inspect the site of the work and to inform himself regarding all local conditions under which the work is to be done. It shall be understood and agreed that all such factors have been thoroughly investigated and considered in the preparation of the bid submitted.

Bid documents may be obtained from www.CivCastUSA.com, search City of Humble, Harris County. Bidders must register on this website in order to view and/or download specifications, plans, and bid documents for this project. There is NO charge to view or download documents.

The Contractor and all Subcontractors for this project will be required to pay not less than the prevailing wage rates for the area of the project as determined by the Owner and listed in the project manual.

Upon consideration of the proposals the City Council plans to award a Contract; however the City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any and all formalities and technicalities, and to accept any bid which it deems advantageous to the City. Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation or recommendation of any bid. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a performance bond and payment bond in an amount of 100% of the total contract price.
