PUBLIC WORKS: A YEAR IN REVIEW

Throughout the past year, the Public Works Department focused on maintaining and improving the infrastructure that supports daily life in our city. Below is a snapshot of work completed in 2025:

Infrastructure

- Replaced 7,746 ft. of 6" & 8" sewer lines
- 494 ft of 10" sewer lines

Water & Sewer

- Performed 28 major water line repairs
- Performed 23 major sewer main/line repairs

Streets & Sidewalks

- Performed 31 sidewalk repairs
- Performed 40 pothole repairs
- Removed 31 deceased animals from roadways

Water Supply

- Pumped 576,783,000 gallons of drinking water
- Provided an additional 506,269,000 gallons through the City's interconnect with Houston

GENERAL ELECTION CANCELLED

The City of Humble will cancel the Municipal General Election that was scheduled for Saturday, May 2, 2026, after all candidates filed unopposed for the available City Council positions.

The candidate filing period closed at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 13, 2026, and the deadline for write-in candidates to declare their candidacy was 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 17, 2026. With no contested races, state law allows the City to cancel the election.

As a result, the following candidates will be declared elected and sworn into office in the same manner as if the election had been held:

- **Bruce Davidson**, City Council Place 3
- **Paula Settle**, City Council Place 4
- **Rick Swanson**, City Council Place 5

These councilmembers will be officially declared elected and take the oath of office during the regular City Council meeting on **May 14, 2026**, when the election canvass would normally take place. Congratulations to these individuals and thank you for your continued service and commitment to the Humble community!
