CITY COUNCIL UPDATES

City Council recently approved two bids to maintain our roadways. The first is a joint and crack sealing project for Public Works, which fills cracks in pavement to keep water out and prevent potholes down the line. The second is a roadway striping project to refresh faded lane lines, crosswalks, and turn arrows for driver and pedestrian safety. Together, these projects reflect the City's commitment to safe, well-maintained roads.
