CALL TO ORDER.

Committee Chair Peters called the meeting to order at 10:37 a.m. with a quorum present.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

The purpose of this item is to allow citizens an opportunity to address the governing board on items that are listed on the agenda, or issues that are not listed on the agenda (non-agenda comments).

REGULAR AGENDA:

1. Discussion and possible action on approval of minutes from the April 9, 2025 meeting.

Committee Member Matthews moved to approve minutes from the April 29, 2025, meeting, Committee Member Mayweather seconded. **MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.**

2. Discussion and possible action on approval of the next committee meeting date of 2025.

After some discussion, it was decided November 5, 2025, would be the next tentative meeting date pending approval from all members via email.

3. Discussion and possible action regarding updated grant numbers for free Spay and Neuter Program.

Committee Member Love reported Deerbrook Mall had only sent 10 cats through the program, and recommended discussion with Mall personnel to try to increase those numbers, as the grant that funds the program covers 50 cats and the Mall is a hot spot for feral cats. Committee Member Mayweather asked if the grant covered flea prevention. While it does not, Committee Member Love said she would get Animal Control information on how to obtain and utilize the flea and heartworm meds more effectively. **NO ACTION TAKEN.**

4. Discussion and possible action regarding the numbers for adoptions, rescues, registrations and other relevant statistics since the last meeting.

Committee Member Mayweather reported that since January, 72 dogs and 119 cats have been brought to the shelter. 47 dogs and 37 cats have been adopted out. There were 3 animals euthanized, but all were the result of being brought in with irreparable injuries. Committee Chair Peters reported the shelter is full, but they have many adoption events coming up, including a mega-event at NRG Center on August 8, 2025, at which all animals at the shelter will have the opportunity to be adopted. **NO ACTION TAKEN.**

5. Discussion and possible action regarding any potential shelter improvement items for the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget.

Committee Chair Peters reported that a new industrial washer and dryer have been purchased, new drains were installed at the outside kennels, and new outside wash stations were installed. For the FY 2026 budget, he is looking to have new security cameras installed inside the shelter for volunteers who come in after hours. They are also working on a dog “Mom Barn” where a mother with puppies can stay, and are taking bids for a new sidewalk for the South side of the shelter. **NO ACTION TAKEN.**

6. ADJOURN.

With no further business to discuss, Committee Chair Peters adjourned the meeting at 11:04 a.m.
