

**CITY OF HUMBLE
REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS
BID 2026-07**

The City of Humble is requesting competitive sealed proposals from qualified construction companies capable of constructing a 30'x75' engineered steel storage building. The successful vendor shall furnish all labor, supervision, and supplies necessary to complete the services. Proposals will be evaluated based on competitive pricing, years of experience, and listed references.

Sealed proposals, in duplicate, should be addressed to the Finance Director, City of Humble, 114 W Higgins St, Humble, Texas 77338 and shall be labeled: "Sealed Proposal Number 2026-07 DO NOT OPEN" and should be received no later than 10:00 A.M. on September 9, 2026. Proposals will be opened publicly and read aloud at that time in the City Council Chambers.

A MANDATORY Pre-Proposal meeting and walk-through are scheduled for September 2, 2026, at 10:00 A.M. at the Humble Parks Department Office located at 1423 S. Houston Ave., Humble, TX 77338. Prospective vendors will be required to sign in and will be able to ask questions and receive information. Proposals received from vendors that did not attend the mandatory pre-proposal meeting will not be accepted.

It is the sole responsibility of the proposer to ensure that his/her bid is in the City of Humble Finance Director's Office prior to the expiration of the time and date above first written.

It shall be each proposer's sole responsibility to inspect the site of the work and to inform him/herself regarding all local conditions under which the work is to be done. It shall be understood and agreed that all such factors have been thoroughly investigated and considered in the preparation of the proposal submitted.
