#### CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS & DEADLINE TO FILE

##### CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Must be a United States Citizen
2. Must be a registered voter on the date of the election
3. Must be a resident of the City of Humble for one (1) year prior to the date of the election
4. Must be 18 years of age
5. Have not been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be totally mentally incapacitated; or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote
6. Have not been finally convicted of a felony from which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities
7. Must satisfy any other requirements prescribed by law for the office
8. Candidate Packets, including the application are available in the City Secretary's Office the first week of January.
9. **Candidates are strongly encouraged to obtain a candidate packet.**

**Wednesday, January 18, 2023 -**  
First Day to File for Place on General Election Ballot

**Friday, February 17, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. -**  
Last Day to File for Place on General Election Ballot
