**RESOLUTION NO. 22-858**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE, TEXAS, ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF CERTIFIED ESTIMATED TAXABLE VALUE, CERTIFIED APPRAISAL ROLL, CERTIFIED ANTICIPATED COLLECTION RATE, TAX RATE CALCULATION WORKSHEET AND RELATED INFORMATION; ADOPTING THE CALCULATED TAX RATE USING THE VALUES SHOWN IN THE CERTIFIED APPRAISAL ROLL AS THE CITY'S PROPOSED 2022 TAX RATE TO BE CONSIDERED FOR ADOPTION AT A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THAT PURPOSE; AND MAKING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT.**

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2022, the City received the certified estimated taxable value and related information from its assessor and collector of taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has filed a proposed 2022-2023 municipal budget for the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor's proposed municipal budget contains a proposed tax rate based on the certified estimated taxable value to support the proposed budget; and

WHEREAS, on August 31, 2022, the City received the certified appraisal roll, recaps and related information from its assessor and collector of taxes; and

WHEREAS, Section 26.17 of the Tax Code makes reference to "the tax rate proposed by the governing body;" and

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that the tax rate calculated using the values shown in the certified appraisal roll is the appropriate tax rate to be considered for adoption at a public hearing to be held for that purpose, pursuant to Section 26.05 of the Tax Code; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Tax Code requires that the City Council designate an employee or official to perform certain functions in connection with the tax rate adoption process; now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE, TEXAS, THAT:**

Section 1. The City Council adopts the proposed ad valorem tax rate of \$0.251580 on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) of assessed valuation on all property within the City upon which an ad valorem tax is authorized by law to be levied by the City as the proposed tax rate. The proposed tax rate will be considered for adoption at a public hearing to be held for that purpose, pursuant to Section 26.05 of the Tax Code.

Section 2. The Chief Financial Officer is designated as the officer or employee of the City who will make the calculations required by Section 26.04 of the Tax Code, and will provide information to other governmental entities regarding the adoption of the City's 2022 tax rate.

Section 3. The Chief Financial Officer and City Secretary are directed to provide the required notices, and publish the required information concerning the City's proposed 2022 tax rate, including the time and date for a public hearing on the proposed 2022 tax rate.
