2. Discussion and possible action regarding City of Humble Festivals.
 - a. Music on Main
Over 20 cars were displayed on Main Street. The antique car show was well received and anticipating another show in conjunction with Music on Main in the future (possibly December 9). Another block may be added to be closed off. John Amore performed on October Music on Main.
 - b. Good Oil Days – April 1
Plans continue.
3. Discussion and possible action regarding Main Street and historic Downtown Humble.
 - a. Plaque Dedication Update
Plans are to present the historical plaques by the end of the year. Bruce will coordinate with the mayor on dates for presentation then with people from Humble State Bank, Gertrude's building (where Barks and Bubbles currently is), Jewel Theatre and Lloyds Bar are completed. Thoughts are to possibly do three plaques a quarter.
 - b. Uptown Park – Plans have been rendered but not public yet.
 - c. Artesian Well – work continues. Completion possible in three weeks.
 - d. 515 Main (empty lot) – will be grassed, decorative fence put up.
 - e. Street lights are out throughout city. Fidel said he would follow up with checking on the lights.
4. Discussion and possible action regarding Code Enforcement – areas of concern within the city.
 - a. The city cleaned up debris at house 610 Welch.
 - b. Lawlers is about to do an expansion – much work being done to ensure all deadlines will be met.
 - c. Fidel will check on the burned out lights throughout the city.
5. Discussion and possible action regarding Old Cemetery on South Houston.
 - a. The plans for Veteran's Day presentation are all in place. Presentation will be November 11, 2022 at 11:00 am. Excess on hand challenge coins will be given out again this year.
 - b. DAR has finished working on headstones.
 - c. Margaret Jo will place bows on the cemetery fence area Thanksgiving weekend.
 - d. Margaret Jo will put out wreaths at cemetery for wreaths over Texas.
6. Discussion and possible action regarding Christmas Parade:
 - a. Theme – Discussion around theme for next year. Will vote on at next meeting.
 - b. No discussion.
 - c. Ornaments are on display and sale at City Hall.
 - d. Lighting and sound being handled by Fidel. All on point.

 - f. Route will continue down Main Street to South Houston and onto the Gospel Assembly where floats can stop and unload. Need to ensure everyone is aware of route.
 - g. Street decorations should be hung by November 14. Jennifer will need to be notified about advertising parade on light signs.
 - h. Judges – No discussion.
 - i. Radios – to be finalized later
 - j. Golf carts to be finalized later.
 - k. Floats – a drawing of the city float was passed around.
 - l. Dignitary vehicles – No discussion
 - m. School bands – Humble and Summer Creek are to perform.
 - n. Banner Bearers – Humble High School has volunteered. Gwen has banners from last year.
 - o. Food Trucks – Gwen is working on food trucks and placement of trucks on Main Street.
 - p. Parade Reception to be held at Charles Bender.
 - i. Madrigals

 - iii. Discussion on how to get officials and judges to parade route.
