Regular Agenda:

No changes were noted in last month's minutes.

MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

1. Discussion and possible action regarding City of Humble Festivals.
 - a. Music on Main – Amy and Me will perform on July 14, 2023. Antique cars will be on display again this month along Main Street. Food trucks expected will be Hot Diggity Dog, Cousins Lobsters and snow cones.
 - b. Pop-ups are okay at Music on Main – no fees at this time. Limit of four pop-ups will be allowed.
 - c. People need to register if they are doing something for the event so that sponsors know who will be there (i.e., popups and antique cars).

2. Discussion and possible action regarding Main Street and historic Downtown Humble.
 - a. There will be a possible Farmer's Market first week in August on the Main Street lot.
 - b. October 14, 2023 cleanup – same place unless Uptown Park is under construction.

- c. Museum parking lot on Main Street – the bid goes out on July 6, 2023. Vision is for this to be a food court area with outlets.
 - d. Centerpoint will come out and will plant trees on Wildcat Den park area.
 - e. Discussion took place around more lights being needed on Main Street for the Parade.
 - f. Uptown Park bids are going out on July 12, 2023. Current plans are that the park will be finished by December.
 - g. Texas Downtown meeting will be held at the Stander venue, 317 Main Street to discuss findings and path forward with merchants and residents.
3. Code Enforcement – Complaint made about the roosters on Avenue E being noisy. Tickets will be issued to the owners of the North Houston property that has overgrown yard.
 4. Cemetery – Margaret Jo and Margaret put out flags on the cemetery fence for July 4. A section of the fence is down at the cemetery.
 5. Christmas Parade - Parade Marshal has not been chosen – still under consideration.
 6. Concluded that we order the minimum amount of ornaments . It was presented that the Lake Houston Partnership be considered for an ornament as this is the 100 year anniversary. The majority of the committee did like that idea.

The next Beautification meeting will be held August 2, 2023 at 3:30.

With no further business to discuss Lois Bean made the motion to adjourn at 5:01.
