## IMPORTANT ELECTION DATES

### GENERAL ELECTION OF CITY OFFICERS

MAY 4, 2024

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<b>Wednesday January 17, 2024</b>	First day for filing an application for a place on ballot; and, first day for filing declaration of write-in candidacy for the General election.
<b>Monday January 22, 2024 to Friday February 16, 2024</b>	Recommended period and statutory deadline for ordering the election.  <i>The City of Humble will order the election during the Thursday, January 25, 2024 or Thursday, February 8, 2024 regular City Council meeting at 6:30 p.m. The official agenda will be posted to the City's website (<a href="https://www.cityofhumbletx.gov/council-meetings/">https://www.cityofhumbletx.gov/council-meetings/</a>) at least 72 hours before the meeting date.</i>
<b>Friday February 16, 2024</b>	Last day to file application for place on ballot in the General election. <b>(Must be received by 5:00 p.m.)</b>
<b>Tuesday February 20, 2024</b>	Last day for a write-in candidate to declare candidacy in the General election. <b>(Must be received by 5:00 p.m.)</b>
<b>Friday February 23, 2024</b>	Last day for a ballot or write-in candidate in General election to <u>withdraw</u> and have name removed.  <b>(Must receive in writing by 5:00 p.m.)</b>
<b>Thursday February 22, 2024 to Monday February 26, 2024</b>	Recommended period to conduct a drawing for the order of names on the ballot.  The drawing will be held <b>10:00 a.m.</b> on February 26, 2024 at the City of Humble, Council Chambers, 114 W. Higgins St., Humble, Texas 77338.  <b>(All candidates will be notified if change in date is made.)</b>
<b>Thursday April 4, 2024</b>	1st report of Candidate/Officeholder Campaign Finance Report due by 5:00 p.m., or midnight if filed electronically, by opposed candidates and specific-purpose committees supporting or opposing candidates. <b>This is the 30-day prior to Election Day report.</b>
<b>Thursday April 4, 2024</b>	Last day for submitting voter registration application to Harris County in time to vote at the election or for requesting transfer of registration in time to vote in new precinct not in the same county and territory.

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<b>Thursday, April 4, 2024 to Wednesday, April 24, 2024</b>	Period for publishing the notice of election in the newspaper. <i>Tentative plans are to publish the notice in the Wednesday, April 10, 2024 edition of the Humble Observer newspaper.</i>
<b>Sunday April 21, 2024 6:00 p.m.</b>	Candidate political signs may be posted throughout the City of Humble on city owned or controlled property starting at 6:00 p.m. It is an offense for any person to leave any electioneering sign or literature on city-owned or -controlled property that is used as a polling place other than during the period beginning on 6:00 p.m. before the voting period begins.
<b>Monday April 22, 2024</b>	First day for early voting by personal appearance begins.
<b>Tuesday April 23, 2024</b>	Last day Harris County accepts an application for a ballot to be voted by mailed by noon or close of business.
<b>Friday April 26, 2024</b>	2nd report of Candidate/Officeholder Campaign Finance Report due by 5:00 p.m., or midnight if filed electronically. <b>This is the 8-day prior to Election Day report.</b>
<b>Tuesday April 30, 2024</b>	Last day of early voting by personal appearance.
<b>Saturday May 4, 2024</b>	<b>ELECTION DAY ** 7:00 A.M. TO 7:00 P.M.</b>
<b>Monday May 6, 2024 7:00 p.m.</b>	Last day all candidate political signs <b>must</b> be removed throughout the City of Humble on city-owned or controlled property. It is an offense for any person to leave any electioneering sign or literature on city-owned or -controlled property that is used as a polling place other than during the period ending forty-eight (48) hours after the voting period ends.
<b>Wednesday May 8, 2024</b>	Deadline for winning candidates to inform the City Secretary whom will be swearing them into office. <b>(Must receive in writing by 5:00 p.m.)</b> <i>The City Secretary's Office will confirm eligibly by or before the third business date.</i>
<b>Tuesday May 7, 2024 to Wednesday May 15, 2024</b>	Period for official canvass.  Oaths of office for newly elected officers.  <b>IF A RUNOFF ELECTION IS NEEDED</b> , the City will order the runoff not later than 5 days after the canvass or at the canvass meeting. <b>NOTE: NEW LAW (HB 88)</b> The order of the names on the runoff ballot should be in the same order as they appeared on the general election ballot, no ballot drawing is required for the runoff ballot.
