WARRANT AMNESTY PERIOD

Have an unpaid speeding or other ticket? The Municipal Court is running its inaugural Warrant Amnesty Program through March 31st. Individuals with outstanding fines and warrants are encouraged to make arrangements without fear of arrest during the month of March. Those who contact the Humble Municipal Court during the amnesty program could have warrant fees reduced or waived, receive a reduction in the fine amount, and have their Failure to Appear Violations dismissed. We’re telling you this because beginning on April 1st, the Municipal Court and Humble Police will be conducting a Warrant Round-Up with the goal of nabbing as many individuals with outstanding warrants as possible. OPEN BURNING IS PROHIBITED

Many are in the process of doing a bit of spring clean-up around their yards. Consider this your friendly reminder that open burning of yard waste is prohibited in the City. This includes burning leaves and other debris in barrels, portable fireplaces or pits. Don’t get burned – bag your yard waste and dispose of it properly.

TRASH BELONGS IN CONTAINERS

While we’re on the subject, except for bulky waste and bulk cardboard, all solid waste, green waste or recyclables must be placed for pick-up in a cart or residential container, i.e. – a garbage can. It is prohibited to place uncontained or otherwise uncontrolled trash in your yard or on the curb for pick-up. Help us keep your city clean!

The \$112,000 project includes a large covered area consisting of six pieces of outdoor workout equipment that utilize body weight for resistance.
