The General Election for City Council Member Places 3, 4 and 5 will be on Saturday, May 4th. Early Voting begins on Monday, April 22 through Friday, April 26 and Monday, April 29 through Tuesday, April 30 from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Election day voting will be held from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. All voting takes place at City Hall located at 114 W.
