



2025 BUDGET APPROVED

The City Council has approved the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget, which totaled over \$126 million, and we thought you'd like to know where your money is being spent this year...

- \$27.2 million in infrastructure projects including streets, water / wastewater, and drainage
- Half a million to establish a real-time crime center to increase our ability to investigate and deter crime
- \$1 million to improve IT capabilities to better serve you more efficiently.



General Fund expenditures total \$50.9 million, of which \$12.1 million is for one-time capital expenses. The infographic above shows how each of your dollars is spent across the city departments. When it is all said and done, we are forecasting a General Fund reserve of \$36.4, which is approximately 71% of our annual expenditures – meaning, the city's finances are in a very healthy condition. Additionally, this year's budget is fully balanced and the city continues to not have to rely on bonded debt to provide exceptional services for you.
