OUR WISH LIST

Maybe it's not exactly a Christmas wish list – but there are quite a few things that we have budgeted for this year that we hope to complete....

- \$716,671 for new Police vehicles;
- \$250,000 for equipment and software to build out the new Real Time Crime Center;
- Completion and opening of \$7 million Fire Station No. 2;
- \$3.3 million for engineering and construction of the concrete curb and gutter project for McDugald, Caroline and Anne Streets;
- \$1.75 million for engineering for the improvement of pavement and drainage for Meeks and Manning Road;
- \$1.14 million for engineering for the widening and drainage improvement for S. Houston Avenue from Will Clayton to Atascocita Road;
- \$3.96 million to improve waterline connections between wells and construct new interconnection with the City of Houston;
- \$11 million to complete lift station improvements and construct a new force main from Northshire to the treatment plant;
- \$4.25 million for engineering to improve drainage between 7th Street and the Bypass as well as between Country Village and Treble Drive;
- \$321,250 for renovations, improvements, and repairs to the Civic Center and Civic Arena.
